

NEW fee schedule increases

In recent months, Delta Dental of North Carolina has received feedback from participating dentists, analyzed the prevailing market conditions, and examined our competitive position regarding fee schedules. As a result, we will be implementing targeted increases to select network fees, effective **September 1, 2023**. Updated fee schedules will be available to participating providers as follows:
