# Delta Dental Foundation Awards \$5,000 Smiles for Kids Grant to Guilford County Public Health, Totaling \$34,000 in Giving Since 2014

The 2019 Smiles for Kids grant will support their Project Access Dental Program

Greensboro, NC (October 24, 2019) – The Guilford County Department of Health and Human Services, Public Health Division received a \$5,000 Smiles for Kids grant from the <u>Delta Dental Foundation</u> (DDF) to advance the oral health of uninsured and underinsured children in Guilford County through their *Project Access Dental* (PAD) Program. This grant will assist the program in securing treatment for approximately 20 children who, through in-school dental screenings, have been identified with urgent dental care needs and an inability to pay.

In Guilford County, 17.8 percent of kindergarten children have untreated tooth decay. The Delta Dental Foundation has chosen to support Guilford County Public Health because of their work to change this statistic. The Project Access Dental program reaches approximately 5,000 kindergarten students in Guilford County Schools' 69 elementary schools. Guilford County Public Health in turn becomes the "dental home" for many children who have Medicaid or are uninsured.

"The grant from the Delta Dental Foundation is a great help in getting the students in our PAD program the care they need," said Debbie Kennedy, Guilford County Public Health's School Health Dental Hygienist. "Once the student goes to the dentist through our program and is no longer in pain, the parents begin to see the dentist as a partner in keeping their child's teeth healthy, which contributes to keeping the rest of their body healthy."

The Delta Dental Foundation focuses on ensuring children and adults in North Carolina receive quality oral health education and dental care. The grant received by Guilford County Public Health is one of 19 grants totaling \$70,000 awarded in 2019 to North Carolina oral health organizations and programs. This is the fifth year that the Guilford County Department of Public Health has been awarded a Smiles for Kids grant. Grant recipients were selected based on criteria that included the number of at-risk children served, the uniqueness of the program, the level of community involvement and the ability to measure results.

"The Delta Dental Foundation is committed to promoting good oral health habits and providing better access to quality dental care for those who are underserved in our state," said Curt Ladig, president and CEO of Delta Dental of North Carolina. "Supporting the work of the Guilford County Department of
